SRQ members collectively fund transformational grants in increments of at least \$100,000 to eligible nonprofits serving Sarasota and Manatee Counties in five focus areas: Arts, Culture, & History; Education; Environment & Recreation; Family; and Health & Wellness.

Every year all eligible 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations are invited to apply to receive grant funding for an initiative that will positively impact the community for years to come.

Members can design their own experience with Impact100 SRQ and are encouraged to join a Focus Area Committee to more fully engage in the grant review process.

Member volunteers collectively evaluate each grant application, learn about proposed initiatives, and determine the nonprofit finalists to present to our entire membership for funding consideration.

All Impact100 SRQ members have the unique opportunity to vote at our Annual Celebration and Awards Ceremony to determine which nonprofit finalists will receive funding for their initiative.

Nonprofit grant recipients receive funding for a specific initiative gaining exposure for their organization through various member events and "Impact in Action" showcases.

The collective giving model of Impact100 SRQ makes philanthropy accessible for all women in Sarasota and Manatee Counties. Individual impact is multiplied by each member allowing us to truly make a difference. In just 5 years since our chapter's inception, we have funded 22 grants, totaling \$2,400,000.
