The Conservation Foundation protects the land and water in Southwest Florida for the benefit of people and nature. The Impact100 SRQ funds are being used to purchase fundamental land-management equipment including a 4-wheel drive truck, an off-road utility vehicle, a transport trailer, a storage shed, and fire equipment. All that supports the restoration, management and monitoring of at least 24 conservation properties that total at least 3000 acres. The wish list below includes additional items needed to support land stewardship.

Wish list (partial donations are welcome)

- \$2,000 for native plant nursery supplies, soil, and pots
- \$2,500 for trail and boundary marker posts and signs
- \$1,200 for a photography drone
- \$508 each for a battery-powered reciprocating saw (up to 6 in total needed)
- \$200 for an electric leaf blower
- Donations to purchase greenies or Jon boats and corresponding trailers (used boats are welcome)



- \$100 each for wildlife/trail monitoring cameras (up to 20 in total needed)
- Donations to the Land Fund, a board-designated fund that is used for land conservation purposes (any amount is welcome)
- Donations to purchase a utility cart for Bay Preserve Park and events free to public
- \$5500 for Planned Giving Pro software
- \$2615 for craft cabinet for storage of small pieces, parts and supplies
- \$3299 for garage cabinet for storage and work surface
- \$1500 for plastic storage bins of various sizes
- \$48 for trash and recycle bins
- \$399 for mini fridge
- \$299 for microwave
- \$1699 for undercounter ice machine
- \$99 for toolbox
- \$60 for door mats
- \$159 for cordless drill
- \$105 for Bluetooth speaker
- \$60000 for 13-passenger van
- \$5500 for kayak 12-boat trailer
- \$92 for kayak straps
- \$1000 for snorkel gear
- \$1018 for dip nets (to replace damaged ones)
- \$1500 for adjustable life jackets
- \$590 for various supplies for insect collection and preservation
- \$1000 for biofacts used in educational programs
- \$140 for small creature viewing containers
- \$1000 for various animal puppets used in children's programs
